SHOW REQUIREMENTS & RULES

NOTE: Registration papers, competition license and membership cards (or facsimiles) must accompany entries. Late fees will apply if payment is not received by deadlines.

A. GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. Open to all breeds and grade horses.
2. Show is not eligible for NRHA Top Ten awards.
3. Anyone on a horse at the show must be an SRHA member.
4. All dogs must be kept on a leash while on show grounds.
5. Competitors must keep aisles clear and safe for travel.
6. **SRHA Classes:** Both owners and riders must be current SRHA members to compete. Memberships may be purchased at the show office.
7. **NRHA Ancillary and Futurity Classes:** Both owners and riders must be current NRHA and SRHA members to compete. Horse must have valid NRHA competition license to compete.
8. **NRHA Green Reiner classes:** Rider may be an NRHA Associate, Youth or Non Pro member and have an SRHA Membership. Horse does not need an NRHA competition license.
9. SRHA and NRHA classes are run under NRHA rules, except where otherwise indicated.
10. **All youth under the age of 18** as of January 1 of the current year will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating.

B. PENALTIES, FINES AND REFUNDS

1. Make cheques payable to SRHA (in Canadian Funds). All accounts must be paid before leaving show grounds.
2. NSF/Returned cheques will incur late fees and a \$25 NSF charge.
3. Stall form and payment must be received by Stall Reservation deadline. **Late stall requests will be charged a \$25/stall late fee.**
4. After October 7th, stall reservations are non-refundable unless accompanied by a vet. or doctor's certificate.
5. Substitutions of horses by owners will be allowed with vet certificate.
6. Any competitor who enters a class in which they are not eligible will incur a \$50 fine.
7. SRHA LTE includes all forms of Reining earnings.
8. Change of ownership: if an entry changes ownership, the entry will retain eligibility by complying with the following steps:
 - i. Ownership legally changes and the new owner has intentions to continue the entry follow NRHA/SRHA rules.
 - ii. Payment of remaining fees.
 - iii. The new owner becoming a member of the SRHA and/or NRHA as required by the classes being entered and meets class eligibility rules.

C. PAYOUTS

1. NRHA payout formulas will be used to payout in all NRHA classes, including NRHA fees and trophy deductions.
2. SRHA will retain 50% of entry fees and pay put 50%.

D. DIVISIONS

1. Non Pro's that do not have a valid NRHA Non Pro card will be required to sign an SRHA Non Pro declaration form. Horse must be owned solely by the rider, rider's family or company.
2. Para Reining will follow World Para Reining (WPR) rules or follow SRHA rules where WPR rules do not exist. Para Reining will be separated according to rider's Grade (1-4).

E. EQUIPMENT AND GENERAL SCORING

1. All classes will follow NRHA rules unless otherwise stated.
2. Futurity classes will follow NRHA rules regarding Aged show conditions. Horses may be shown one-handed in a bridle or two-handed in a snaffle or hackamore.
3. After each work, headstalls may be dropped and viewed by the appointed representative of the SRHA.
4. Judges for the Futurity will be selected by the SRHA.
5. Any pattern rule change will be posted one hour before the go round to which it applies.

F. WAIVER

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each entrant by the act of entry or exhibiting, waives all claims against the Saskatchewan Reining Horse Association, Prairieland Park, and/or any members, officers or agents thereof, for any and all injury, loss or damage which in any way out of the operations or activities of the said associations and Prairieland Park by reason of any claim made by any of his helpers or employers or their executors, administrators, or assigns and that any helpers or employers of their executors, administrators or assigns and that any helpers or assistants introduced to or engaged by an entrant through the said association, or any of them or through the member, offices or agents shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such entrant.

G. RIGHTS RESERVED BY SRHA

1. The SRHA reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. All decisions are final.
2. The SRHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the Futurity without notice and liability. In the event of cancellation, all entry fees will be refunded.
3. The SRHA board reserves the right to deliberate before ruling on any matter not covered within the show rules.

H. NOTICE TO CONTESTANTS

1. Concerns should be directed to Show Manager or NRHA Rep.
2. **Mistreatment of animals will not be tolerated.**
3. All contestants and spectators are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship and fair play.
4. In case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to the disqualified animal and the other prizes adjusted accordingly.
5. **Eligibility:** It is the competitors' responsibility to know their earnings and enter classes according. Please refer to eligibility sheet in show package. Competitors will be subject to a fine if found ineligible (as per Section B).
6. **Entries:** Pre-registration is still the preferred method. Post entries will close at 4 PM the day prior to class. Draws will be posted by 7 PM the day prior. Late entries will be accepted up until one hour before class (a \$15 late fee will apply). Late entries will go at the end of the draw. Please inform the show office or show manager as soon as possible if you intend to scratch from any number of classes.
7. Completion of entry form and signature of owner and/or exhibitor will indicate acceptance of the above rules and regulations.
8. All Fees & winnings are in Canadian funds (CAD), but NRHA earnings will be converted to USD for NRHA records.
